Dyno Days !!! by John Wilson

On the crisp fall morning of October 15th, 6 club members met at Roberts Imports at Roberts Imports in Jeffersontown. Robert's dyno tests on Dyno Dynamics which is a brake dyno versus the more common inertia dyno. Results are typically 18% less than the results from an inertia dyno. Bill Roberts was a great host with great assessments and comments on tuning. Attending were John Ackerman, Dan Miller, Alex Jung, Andy and Samantha Floyd, Darrel Clem, and John Wilson. Several others showed up to watch the results. Alex Jung with his E36 M3 with turbo and 23# of boost posted an amazing 454 horsepower equal to approximately 535 wheel horsepower on an inertia dyno. Dan Miller with his modified E46 M3 posted 257 horsepower and 220 torque. Andy Floyd in his stock E46 M3 posted 246 horsepower. Darrel Clem with modified exhaust on his E46 M3 posted 246 horsepower. John Wilson posted 217 horsepower and 215 torque with his E36 M3.

John Ackerman pulled the greatest horsepower gain in the shortest period of time. On his first pull john pulled 50 HP in his E30 325 track car. He had said it felt a little flat in the straightaways. Not a man to be satisfied with the status quo, John went back to his trunk, pulled out another ECU, switched it with the first, and pulled 115 horsepower on the second pull. 130% gain in 30 seconds!!
