

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2012 Helmet Requirements



As of January 1, 2012, all participants in our autocross and driving school events must wear a helmet that meets the Snell Foundation 2005 or 2010 standard. Check your helmet; if it has an older sticker, it is out of date and it's time to get a new one (online, race shops, motorcycle shops are good sources). All Chapter driving activities are conducted under BMW CCA Minimum Standards to qualify for the Club's insurance policy. Quoting from the Standards document:

Example: If the current standard is Snell 2010, then helmets meeting either Snell 2010 or the prior 2005 standard are always allowed. In addition, Snell 2000 helmets may be used through the grace period until the end of calendar 2011. (Section 3.8)

Helmet materials do deteriorate with age, and they are less able to protect you from a knock on your noggin' as they get older. We will be checking for a Snell 2005 or 2010 sticker (either M or SA), so we don't want you to be left out of the events you register for. A limited number of current helmets are available for rental, but we must prioritize offering them to newcomers to driving events. See you out there!

Bring your Favorite Ride on Sunday March 4th

Online Registration will be open from February 11 – 28th The first 20 non-BMWs to register are guaranteed a spot

e all have our favorite ride, that 4-wheeled toy just waiting to get out of the garage and play. Here's your next chance! On Sunday March 4th, we'll set up a challenging course in Qualcomm's Southeast Lot (turn LEFT at the main entrance) for all to enjoy. Since Daylight Savings Time hasn't extended our sunshine yet, we're limited to 80 entries and will hold up to 20 spots for non-BMW drivers who register in advance. If this is your first autocross of the year, remember the helmet standard has changed to require Snell 2005 or 2010 ratings. Check yours to be sure it's up to date-rentals are very limited. Our thanks to BMW of South County in El Cajon for supporting our Autocross program again this year. With online registration, local drivers, longdistance travelers and non-BMW competitors can reserve their spot, so don't miss it. You can register between February 11th-28th. Online registration opens 3 weeks before the event and closes just a few days before. Don't wait until the last minute because it's still first-come, first-

served (with no online waiting list) and we only have 80 spots. We'll still offer registration on-site if any openings are left.

The entry fee is \$65, including breakfast items, lunch and beverages. You can pay online if you register in advance at http://sdbmwcca. motorsportreg.com, or register on site with cash or check if you wait. You must be a BMW CCA member to participate, and you can join online at www.bmwcca.org in advance. Please print and bring your membership confirmation if you have not yet received your BMW CCA membership card. We check membership of all participants at the gate. Our Chapter autocross policy gives priority to members who are driving BMWs or MINIs. Members driving non-BMWs will be allowed to participate if space is available. If we still have openings after online registration, we will allow registration on-site on a first-come, firstserved basis.

REMEMBER: IF REGISTERED ONLINE, BRING PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP AND ARRIVE BY 7:30 (BEFORE ON-SITE CUT-OFF) TO KEEP YOUR RESERVED SPOT

When you arrive:

1. If you registered online, stop at the gate to sign the waiver and notify the Gate Greeter. Your name will be checked off the pre-registration list. All participants must show their BMW CCA membership card. Those who did not register online will receive a numbered card at the gate in their order of arrival; take it to the Registration table. There is no guarantee that spots will be available for those who wait to register the day of the event.

2. Empty all loose items from your car, then go through the Tech Line and have your car inspected. Bring your Tech card and you will receive Tech and helmet stickers.

 Take Gate card and Tech card to Registration to get checked off for pre-registration or pay your \$65 entry fee. You will receive car numbers to place on your side windows.

4. If you don't have a helmet, you can rent one from the club for \$10.

5. Your entry fee of \$65.00 includes one lunch and unlimited beverages. Additional lunches can be purchased at Registration for \$7 each.

Gates will open at 6:30am; tech and registration will open at 7:00am. Tech will close at 8:20am and no cars will be inspected or allowed to run after this time. There is a mandatory drivers meeting at 8:30am and the course opens for runs at 9:00am.

Car Classifications:

- **6S** Stock 6 or 8 cylinder BMWs up to 295 stock horsepower
- 6M Modified 6 or 8 cylinder BMWs up to 295 stock horsepower
- **TS** Stock 6-8-12 cylinder BMWs over 295 stock hp, M cars before 1994
- **TM** Modified 6-8-12 cylinder BMWs over 295 stock hp, M cars before 1994
- MS Stock M cars, 1994 present

- MM Modified M cars, 1994 present
- MC ALL R-class MINI Cooper models
- X ALL non-BMW or MINI models
- **G** Gold Class for all Instructors, opt-in drivers, and cars with slick tires

Stock classes permit any size wheel and tire; non-stock shock absorbers, bushings and strut braces; any brake pad material (brakes must be stock-size), any air filter or cold air intake or catback exhaust; and naturally-aspirated cars may use aftermarket engine management software. Tires must be 140 treadwear rated or higher in Stock. ANY other performance modification, including but not limited to springs, "R"-compound tires, and engine software for turbocharged/ supercharged cars, puts the car in Modified. Non-DOT tires (i.e. slicks) on any car place it in Gold Class. All cars must be under a 92 dB noise level to be driven at Qualcomm-and we'll be checking. Our car classes are kept simple so we can use the honor system.



Women drivers and Novices are classified based upon the car they are driving. We also award a Women's Class trophy to the woman with the fastest time, and two Novice trophies to the two fastest novices. This means women and novices will be eligible for multiple trophies. For example, a very fast novice could win a novice trophy and a trophy in his car class. Remember, you are only a novice for the first and second time you autocross, and if you win a trophy you are now a ringer, not a novice.

Raceway! We are in our second year at this venue and we will be running it in the anti-clockwise direction for the first time. For those of you that were there last year, you would have most certainly enjoyed the bowl section. Trust me when I tell you that it is even more exciting going through it the other way!



Registration has opened on MotorsportReg as of January 11th! Our school is only \$425.00 if you register prior to March 1st. If you register after this date, the cost is \$475.00. If you decide to opt out of our traditional Saturday night banquet/raffle, your pre-March 1st registration cost would only be \$400!

If you are brand new to this and are thinking about trying, rest assured that this is the safest type of environment we can provide in order for you to get the most out of yourself and your car. Our event features two different driving instructors for each beginner or intermediate student, one on Saturday and a different one on Sunday. We do this in order to maximize the feedback that you will get throughout the course of the weekend. For advanced students, we will once again, offer our A+ program. For those of you who have stayed at the Motel 6 (M6 Suites) for many years at Buttonwillow, you will be happy to know that the headquarters for our school will be at the Clarion in Indio. It is a casual 35-40 minute drive west of the track. It will be a great time to catch up with friends you can carpool back with, or you can use the time to dream about the fantastic dinner or what you will win in the raffle. Maybe those Toyo Tires, or some other BMW goodies from BMW Escondido? As another incentive to register before March 1st, our friends at the Clarion Hotel have extended their special pricing to coincide with this date as well. The pricing per night is \$69.00 +tax. After March 1st, room rates will go up to \$85.00 +tax. There is another alternative at the next door Fantasy Springs Resort Casino at \$129.00 per night +tax. This would be a great option for those of you who want to bring a spouse and kids to let them hang loose while you are doing the same thing out on track!

The Clarion will be our event headquarters and we will offer light appetizers at our event registration mixer on Friday night from 6:00-8:00pm in the hotel lobby overlooking the pool. Please bring your SNELL 2005 rated or newer helmet to get signed off during the registration process.

Saturday morning starting at 5:30am there will be a light breakfast available in the lobby area and we'll all want to be at the track by 7:00am to get ready for our drivers meeting followed by our scheduled on-track and classroom activities. There is a full suite of



gas available on-site, including diesel. Keep an eye on your tank level prior to leaving the track for the day as the nearest gas station heading westbound to the hotel is about 20 miles. This year there will be permanent bathroom facilities and other new improvements including semi-permanent classrooms that will make our experience even better.







Please note that we have negotiated a reduced rate that the track will charge every person entering the premises to \$15.00 per person for both days. You will have to pay this entrance fee separately upon initial entry on Saturday morning. The good news is that there is a great BBQ venue at the track and we will be organizing some great lunches for you both days that is part of your registration fee. Please find details on purchasing additional lunch and raffle dinner costs on MotorsportReg.

On Saturday night, we encourage everyone to join us for our traditional dinner/raffle that is always one of the highlights of the weekend. It is a great time to swap stories about almost swapping ends and reveling in the camaraderie we all share. Arrangements are being made for a new dinner location that should result in a much better experience this year.

My team and I are really excited by the prospect of running our High Performance Driving School in the opposite direction. It will offer a completely different experience.

Street Survival provides trained and qualified in-car driving instructors as well as a classroom experience for each student. It is a handson educational driving experience in real-world

situations teaching car safety and control, and challenging driving situations such as skid control and emergency lane changes. All instruction will be held at Qualcomm Stadium where these maneuvers can be safely taught.

The San Diego Chapter of the BMW Car Club of America is holding a Street Survival School on **Sunday, April 1, 2012.** The cost of this one-day school is only \$75 and includes lunch.




