



Plan to join us for our fourth annual car show!


Entry is **free** and the folks at Jackie Cooper BMW provide breakfast and lunch.

ADRENALIN: The BMW Touring Car Story



This two hour documentary of BMW Touring Car Racing is told in detail by the drivers and BMW managers who lived it. If you are at all familiar with BMW racing history, you will recognize the names, and maybe for the first time put a face with them. Very similar in format to Senna, this film contains lots of interviews with the people who made it happen, intermixed with snippets of racing footage from back in the day. The film concentrates on the early period of the 3.0 CSL, M635, and M1 Pro Car, which lead to the E30 M3. There are shots of the BMW Art Cars on track, as well as shorts of the artwork being applied. There is a very short nod to the E36, and only slightly more on the E46 period. The narrative then jumps to BMWs return to DTM, and a look forward to the M4.

The DVD is available from several sources, however you should make sure the version you are buying contains the English sound track, not just subtitles, and is in the NTSC format compatible with your

US DVD player. The version currently available from the BMW CCA Foundation has the English sound track, but some of the Extras are in German only with subtitles. Also, some of the interviews in the main body of the movie are in German, but translation is provided. The sound track is great, crank it up in 5.1 for the sound of BMW racing engines.

Buying your copy from the BMW CCA Foundation provides continued support for the foundation, and for the Street Survival driving program aimed at saving the

lives of young drivers.
