Our March event is a tech session hosted by members Jim and Tim Simpson.


Details: Saturday March 26, 10:00 - whenever 3577 Perch Drive SE, Iowa City

### What is Carnauba?



For years, many of us have heard about using Carnauba wax on our rides but may not have fully understood what that meant. I thought it would be fun to dive in a little deeper and discuss this mystery wax.

Let's start off with what Carnauba is and where it comes from. Carnauba, which is also often called Brazil wax

or palm wax, is indeed a wax that is harvested from the leaves of the palm tree Copernicia prunifera. This palm plant is native to and grown only in the semi-arid northeastern part of Brazil which is the states of Piauí, Ceará, and Rio Grande do Norte.

Carnauba is a thick yellow wax that is produced by the palm tree plant to protect itself from losing too much moisture to the dry air. During the summer, the Carnauba wax is extracted from the palm tree leaves either by boiling the leaves and then skimming the wax from the surface of the mixture or by harvesting the leaves and allowing the wax to dry and then beating the leaves to loosen and remove the wax. After harvesting, the Carnauba wax is in its pure state which is in the form of very hard, yellowish-brown flakes. It is among the hardest of natural waxes, even harder than concrete, and it is nearly insoluble in water and ethanol. The melting point of pure Carnauba wax is also among the highest of natural waxes at 180°F.

The wax is poured into molds and allowed to harden. The Carnauba bricks are then graded according to their yellow coloration and purity. The highest quality Carnauba is rated as #1 Grade Yellow Carnauba, followed by #2 Grade Yellow and #3 Grade Yellow.

When Carnauba is formed into car wax, it must be mixed with solvents in order to be softened so that you can actually apply it to your ride's finish. Products that are advertised as 100% Carnauba are referring to the fact that 100% of the wax content is Carnauba. No

Carnauba wax product can contain more than 28% to 33% of Carnauba wax otherwise it would resemble a block of concrete and be impossible to apply.

In addition, the highest quality Carnauba wax products also contain other ingredients such as resins, silicone oils, polymers and other waxes. These are added in order to give the Carnauba wax product more shine and durability. Carnauba wax in its natural form is not glossy. If you applied it to your ride it would leave a filmy and slightly opaque look. These additional ingredients also add durability as natural Carnauba would only last a month or two.

In the marketplace you may see it advertised as #1 lvory White Pure Carnauba. This description is meant to make you believe that their Carnauba is more refined and all of the impurities (the yellow color) have been removed, therefore it is white. Don't be misled! The finest and purest form of natural Carnauba wax is #1 Yellow Carnauba. There are various shades of yellow due to different ages but they are all yellow. Carnauba can be turned white through a bleaching process or by mixing with other waxes.

Carnauba is highly desired as a car wax. The most common reason is the way that Carnauba wax reflects light. When light is reflected back there is actually a slight distortion that occurs that creates the illusion of wetness and depth. You can increase this illusion by adding multiple layers of Carnauba wax to increase its thickness and deep look.



As your Carnauba wax finish ages, it will begin to turn dull and lose some of its shine. Even some of the best Carnauba waxes can only be expected to last from 3 to 6 months, depending upon many factors such as how often it is washed, how it is washed, the amount of exposure to the outside elements, etc.

If you have never tried Carnauba wax, give it a run. I think you will be pleased with the results. Enjoy your ride!


