# What's in My Garage?

### 2004 Ford SVT F-150 Lightning

In its original form, the 2004 Lightning truck was fitted with the 5.4L single overhead cam engine from the regular F-150, including an Eaton roots supercharger and other performance parts, making 380hp at the crankshaft. The truck was styled as a "step-side" two door with rounded contours, a side outlet exhaust, upgraded suspension and brakes. A heavy duty four speed automatic transmission was taken from the F-350 and the interior was outfitted with sporty faux bucket seats and a full array of gauges.

Even though I am a car guy, I had always wanted a sport truck. When a SVTOA (Special Vehicle Team Owners Association) friend decided to sell his new Lightning. I jumped at the chance. He brought it to a car show at Pandl's in Bayside, I took it for a drive and bought it. Now this Lightning was not stock! My friend had already commissioned major modifications, made by our friend and super mechanic Marv Zuidema who owns C&M Automotive in Hubertus. These mods included: a complete rebuild of the motor with all forged parts, upgraded performance software tuning and MAF, electric fans, aluminum tanks, suspension traction bars, lowering system, and upgraded stall converter. My new toy was massive, loud, angry and fast. It was certainly different from my cars. I love the step-side look which harkens back to 1950s F-100 pickups. In dark shadow gray, my Lightning was #1129 of a build of 3781 in 2004.

Now you would think that I would have been content to stop at that point and just drive the truck, but no.

Instead, I went back to Marv and had him make additional modifications. The supercharger was upgraded to a Whipple, and with dyno tuning, produced 700hp and 750ft lbs. of torque at the engine. This was a "mild" tune with relatively low boost. There remains potential for a lot more power if showing dyno sheets is your bag.

I also added a Magnaflow exhaust, and importantly, much improved front braking (Brembos) which saved almost 100lbs over the stock calipers and rotors. In addition, I added an ARE fiberglass color matched bed cover, a stock heavy duty trailer hitch and wiring, and Nitto high performance tires. Now my show truck can track, drag race, and even tow the boat. I could do "hole shots" from the boat launch ramps in Vilas county!

This Lightning can be seen occasionally throughout the summer at the Brew City Cruise Night car show held at the River Club in Mequon each Tuesday night from May through September. You may also see my 2004 SVT Mustang Cobra, but that's another story.
