#### NOTICE SEEKING CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION OF OFFICERS

#### The current incumbents encourage candidates and nominees - all office positions are open

This November we will hold elections for all officers. Our current officers are President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer are currently combined, but will be split if candidates announce their interest for one, but not as a combined position. You may nominate a candidate but please be sure the person nominated is willing to serve.

Our By-Laws describe each office as follows:

**President** = The President shall be the principal executive officer of the Club and preside at all meetings. The President shall perform the administrative duties usually associated with the office.

**Vice-President** = The Vice-President shall assist the President in the conduct of administrative affairs of the Club and perform such other duties as may be assigned by the President.

**Secretary/Treasurer** = The Secretary/Treasurer, whether as combined or separate officers, shall keep minutes of meetings and report to the Board of Directors on club finances. The Secretary/Treasurer shall be the custodian of the club's funds, corporate documents and archives. The duties shall include the preparation of financial information, financial reports and tax returns as may be required by the BMW Car Club of America, Inc., the Internal Revenue Service, the State of Oklahoma or other appropriate parties needing such information.

This is an excellent way to help grow a successful BMW CCA chapter and influence the events offered to our members.
